## ELEMENTARY PROMOTION POLICY FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

Promotion decisions for ELLs are based on policies and procedures specified in the Promotion Policy. ELLs will complete the general academic curriculum in their native language and/or English.

### Promotion Criteria for Elementary School ELLs

- ELLs in benchmark grades (3, 6, and 8) may be promoted to the next grade if they have a final report card grade of "C" or better in Reading and Mathematics and no more than 9 unexcused absences.
- **No assessment/test scores of any kind are used for promotion for ELLs.** In those instances when the ISAT or DWWA is administered, it shall not be considered for promotion purposes.
- ELLs cannot be retained based upon their English Proficiency Level and/or their Program Year.
- Promotion criteria for Special Education ELLs are aligned with the individual students' IEP.
